

Friday, October 12, 16:30: GOTHENBURG FOR EXPATS AND NEW-ARRIVALS

Start: The waiting room at Stenpiren Resecentrum. **End:** Brunnsparken.

How was Gothenburg founded? Why? Who have been instrumental, and what factors have been important, when influencing the development of our city from a fortified defense point for the Kingdom of Sweden, to an European leader in sustainable solutions and businesses?

This guided walking-tour is aimed towards anybody who wants to understand "the basics" of Gothenburg (historically, today and in the future) and with a reasonable knowledge of the English language.

We begin at the public transportation hub Stenpiren with a guided walk within the general vicinity. We utilize one of the Västtrafik ferries to the Lindholmen Science Park and continue our exploration of Gothenburg by foot. We conclude with a brief presentation and a transfer with the ElectriCity line 55 to Brunnsparken and a brief presentation of "the heart of Gothenburg".
