Some examples of the walks we do in English:

Scots and English Influence in Historical Gothenburg. A stroll in the city centre seen from a British point of view. Start: Kronhusgården outside Café Kronhuset. The walk takes one and a half hours approximately. British guide: Margaret Myers. Tickets: SEK 100 per person.

City Meets Sea. A walk along both sides of the Göta River, including a crossing on Älvsnabben. Start: Eriksberg Färjeläge. The walk takes about two and a half hours and ends on the mainland. Bring SEK 20 or equivalent for ferry ticket. Guide: Margaret Myers. Tickets: SEK 100 per person.

The Old City Centre. Familiar buildings and streets in the old city centre in a less familiar perspective. Start: Kronhusgården outside Café Kronhuset. The walk takes one and a half hours approximately. British guide: Margaret Myers. Tickets: SEK 100 per person.
